



Western Cemetery

Directions

Start at the entrance to the Western Cemetery on Perth Road. Turn to your right and walk along to West Park Road. Opposite you is Harris Academy. Facing away from the cemetery, turn right into West Park Road and walk up to the turn-off on the left for Norwood Crescent. Take this turning and continue to walk up to the end of this street. Turn right at the end of Norwood Crescent onto Blackness Road. Turn off onto the second road on your right, Marchfield Road, and follow it round to Rockfield Street. Turn right onto Rockfield Street and then take the next left onto Shaftesbury Road. Follow this road before turning right onto Blackness Avenue and right again onto Perth Road. Continue along Perth Road and you will be back outside the entrance to the Western Cemetery.

Points of interest

- There are many famous folk buried in the Western Cemetery, including James Bowman Lindsay who inspired Marconi with the idea of wire-less telegraphy.
- Have a wander in and see if you can spot any other local celebrities, such as the carved ornate tomb of Baron Armitstead.
