Balgay Cemetery is part of Greater Balgay, and was purchased from the Balgay Estate of Sir William Scott in 1869 and developed as a park from about 1871.

The Windy Glack (or 'glaik' - meaning a narrow valley) was a haunt of smugglers and ner-do-wells as late as the early 19th century


