Camperdown Wildlife Centre is committed to providing Access for all to ensure that everyone enjoys their visit without barriers.

Access

The Wildlife Centre is situated within Camperdown Country Park on the outskirts of Dundee. The Centre is an 18 acre site which consists of generally flat terrain and is considered reasonably wheelchair and pushchair friendly.

The majority of the paths are tarmac with ramps to all raised viewing areas.

Parking

Parking is free within the park and there are designated disabled parking spaces at the east side of the car park, near the Play complex.
