



CIVIC GOVERNMENT (SCOTLAND) ACT 1982
MARKET OPERATOR'S LICENCE
LIST OF CONDITIONS

1. The use of the premises/site is restricted to the following kind or kinds of market, viz:-
2. The number of persons admitted to the premises/site at any one time shall not exceed:-
3. The premises/site may be open for the purposes of the market only as follows:-
4. To the satisfaction of the City Council's Environmental Health Officers the operator shall ensure that:-
 - (a) suitable and sufficient sanitary accommodation and washing facilities are provided; and
 - (b) such measures as are necessary are taken to prevent noise nuisance to residents and occupiers of premises in the vicinity.
5. The operator shall comply with any order or instruction given by any constable for the prevention of annoyance to the public or to the occupiers of any premises or in connection with any emergency or disturbance (including an order or instruction to close the premises for a limited period) or on any occasion when such constable in his direction may consider it necessary in the public interest to give such order or instruction.
6. The operator shall not in any way alter, erase or deface his licence.
7. The operator shall collect and remove any paper, garbage or other refuse which may be produced or may accumulate in the course of the market.
8. The operator shall comply with or ensure compliance with such recommendations as may be made by Tayside Fire and Rescue and the Council's technical officers.
9. The layout of the site shall be to the satisfaction of the technical officers of this Council and the number of stalls shall not exceed:-
10. The operator shall ensure that he has sufficient staff to supervise the running of the market and compliance with the requirements of the Council's officers.
11. The operator, prior to allowing a second hand dealer or other person requiring a licence to trade within the market, should ensure that they have the appropriate licence issued under the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 or any other legislation.
