

RIDING ESTABLISHMENT

NOTES OF GUIDANCE

- 1 A licence may be granted to an individual over the age of eighteen years or a body corporate.
- 2 (i) "Horse" includes any mare, gelding, pony, foal, colt, filly or stallion and also any ass, mule or jennet.

(ii) The Act regulates riding establishments which let out horses on hire or use them for the purpose of providing, in return for payment, instruction in riding or for the purpose of demonstrating riding.
- 3 DVLA Licence details are required by Tayside Police to complete background checks on the applicant.
- 4 A report by a vet will require to be lodged. A style report will be sent to you once the application has been lodged.
- 5 Data Protection Act 1998 - Your Personal Data

Dundee City Council respects your personal information and undertakes to comply with the Data Protection Act 1998. The personal data you have provided will be used to process the application in terms of the Act stipulated on this form. Your data may be disclosed to Tayside Police and other Council departments involved in the processing of the application and elected members when considering the application.
