Entries in the School or Nursery Garden Section must include a display of photos and drawings featuring the garden on a board not to exceed A2. These will be collected when the garden is judged. These displays will automatically be entered into the appropriate 'Our Environmental Actions' Section at the Dundee Flower and Food Festival 2012.

What Happens Next

- Judging for the School or Nursery Garden will take place on Thursday 14th June.
- Judging for the Allotment Competition will take place on Wednesday 11th July.
- Judging for the Garden Competition will take place in July
- Depending on the number of entries, pre judging may be carried out.
- We will contact you to let you know whether you have won one of the prizes.
- All entrants will receive a certificate and category winners will be invited to the Presentation of Prizes Evening in November.

Judging Criteria

The independent judge will mark against a set of standards.

Prizes

All Category Winners

Competition Categories

Allotment Competition

1. Corporation Trophy for Allotments over 7 poles.
2. Phin Cup for Allotments 7 poles and under.
3. W. Robertson Trophy for Senior Citizen Allotment Holders only.

Garden Competition

4. Residential Front Garden or Entrance.
5. Residential Garden for Council House Tenants. (including housing associations and Scottish homes)
6. Community Living Spaces (including council tenants, housing associations, care homes or sheltered housing).
7. School or Nursery Garden.
8. Display of Window Boxes and/or Patio Planters.
9. Business or Retail Premises (excluding Cat 10).
10. Public House, Hotel or Guest House.
11. Place of Worship.
12. New Entrant.
13. A Space for Wildlife (An imaginative way to attract wildlife into your green space)
