## GRANT FUND : YOUTH ARTS

### **Purpose**

To support the development of innovative activities and experiences that encourage young people's creativity and inclusion in the arts.

### **Who can apply?**

Groups of young people between the ages of 12 and 25. In particular, groups who have little or no access to innovative, quality arts experiences.

### **What grants will be awarded for**

Grants of up to £1,000 will be awarded to initiatives that address current gaps in arts provision for young people in Dundee. There are two main categories:

#### **Young People's participation in the Arts.**

- going to arts events such as performances, exhibitions etc
- taking part in local or national arts programmes, courses and workshops

#### **Youth Arts development.**

- planning and delivering a Youth Arts project
- creative collaborations between Youth Arts groups
- planning and holding a Youth Arts exhibition or performance

### **Exclusions**

The fund cannot be used to:

- subsidise staffing costs for additional programme staff other than artists or creative specialists
- support to non-arts youth programmes

Applications cannot be accepted from Arts organisations or agencies, Schools or Further Education Colleges.

### **How to apply**

The Department's application for grant aid should be completed. One copy of the completed form should be returned to the Leisure & Communities Department and one retained by the applicant.  
*N.B. For consideration in the current year, completed applications should be submitted by 16 May 2008.*

### **Advice to applicants**

Applications should be submitted with as much detail as possible, including who will be involved; what the group hopes to achieve; how this will be done; how the proposed activity will fit with current and future plans for the development of the group.

Bear in mind that the assessment criteria emphasise initiatives that include: young people's active participation in the design and development of creative projects; the involvement of professional artists; local importance and city-wide significance; the uniqueness of the activity (i.e. dealing with a topic or activity not previously undertaken)

Successful applicants will be required to provide a short report to the Youth Arts Fund and if possible, provide photographic documentation of the activity; and acknowledge the support of the Youth Arts Fund in any publications, reports and publicity relevant to the activity supported by grant aid.

Please note that information regarding successful applications may be used by DCC Leisure & Communities Department in reports, and included in any publicity relating to the Youth Arts Fund.
