#### 1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 This report details the request for continuation of Service Level Agreements with Dundee College and Craigowl Communities for the delivery of literacy support.

#### 2.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

- 2.1 Approval is recommended for the continuation of the Service Level Agreement with Craigowl Communities (Tender Ref LTS/29/02/12) to deliver literacy services focused on employability; for the period 1 April 2013 31 March 2014, at the level of £26,000.
- 2.2 Approval is recommended for the continuation of the Service Level Agreement with Dundee College to deliver literacy services focused on those wishing to progress to College; for the period 1 April 2013 31 March 2014, at the level of £35,000.

#### 3.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 The expenditure of £61,000 can be met from the 2013/14 Communities & Policy Division revenue budget.

## 4.0 MAIN TEXT

- 4.1 In consultation with partners, a Literacies Strategic Action Plan is in place for the period 2011-2014, this was approved in Committee Report No 203-2011.
- 4.2 Craigowl Communities were successful in tendering for literacy services focused on employability and were awarded the Service Level Agreement for the period 2012/13, with an option to extend for a further year, if they successfully met the outcomes detailed in the Service Level Agreement.
- 4.3 Craigowl Communities has met the outcomes of their Service Level Agreement. It is recommended to extend the current Service Level Agreement to 31 March 2014, based on past performance.
- 4.4 Dundee College has met the outcomes of their Service Level Agreement. It is recommended to continue the Service Level Agreement to 31 March 2014, based on past performance.
