1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To seek the Committee's approval to change the manner in which charges for certain City Council facilities are organised by establishing a series of co-ordinated corporate charges.

2.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that the Committee:

- 2.1 approve the proposed introduction of co-ordinated corporate charges and the associated changes to the City Council's charges.
- 2.2 approve the associated Policy of Use
- 2.3 refer this report to the Leisure and Culture Dundee Board, once established, for their interest.

3.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 There are no direct financial implications arising from this report.

4.0 MAIN TEXT

- 4.1 Reference is made to Article II of the Policy & Resources Committee of the 10 February 2011, Revenue Budget and Council Tax 2011/2012, where the Committee approved the Review of Charges 2011/2012.
- 4.2 To enable the harmonisation and standardisation of the numerous and often confusing or contradictory charges for facilities across the Council, it is proposed to establishing co-ordinated corporate charges covering the areas of Sports provision, Room/Hall hire and Pitch hire. This will remove the inconsistency in how charges are determined, with a historical range presently existing from individuals to groups to sessions to term time prices. All would transfer to cost per each session or activity. It will still be possible to have multiple/season bookings but the charges will be the same for each time the facility or activity is utilised.
- 4.3 The charges being proposed are targeted at supporting wider access to Council facilities and as well as maximising usage by focusing on Individuals and Groups from the Community Regeneration Priority Areas, encouraging increased physical activity and voluntary provision in terms of the concession rates. This is captured in the associated Policy of Use which is attached to this report as Appendix 1. This policy provides the criteria for standard, concession and commercial charges for the use of facilities. The Committee is asked to approve it for future use, including a referral to the Board of Leisure and Culture Dundee with a recommendation for their adoption.
- 4.4 It is proposed that co-ordinated corporate charges are established as per Appendix 2 and are continued to be aligned over future years. This will, in the first instance, cover

the provision by Communities Division and Education Department as well as alignment with Dundee Leisure and their successor, Leisure and Culture Dundee.

- 4.5 The principle of the co-ordinated corporate charges is that similar facilities are charged at the same rate. In each of the corporate charge categories, facilities of very similar size or quality of provision, have been grouped together and would be charged for at the same or similar rates. The range of charges for each group has also been simplified to make it more understandable to users as well as transparent. It is proposed that some of the charges take up to 4 years to align and that there is an appeals process introduced for this period. This will enable groups to put their case to the relevant Director to consider a variation to the charge for this interim period of up to 4 years.
- 4.6 There will be continuing consultation and discussion between the different departments and with Dundee Leisure and its successor Leisure and Culture Dundee in future years so the charges continue to align. This will also include short term discounts, when required, relating to the different external markets that these facilities operate in, and the continued focus on community access.
- 4.7 The proposed charges will be incorporated in to the electronic internet based corporate booking system which is currently being developed and will be the subject of a future committee report.

5.0 POLICY IMPLICATIONS

- 5.1 This report has been screened for any policy implications in respect of Sustainability, Strategic Environmental Assessment, Anti-Poverty, Equality Impact Assessment and Risk Management. No major issues have been identified.

1.0 STANDARD RATES

1.1 The presumption will be that all charges will be standard unless proven to be concession or deemed to be commercial.

2.0 CONCESSION RATE

Individuals

- 2.1 People in receipt of state retirement pension.
- 2.2 Unemployed and/or receiving Income based Job Seekers Allowance.
- 2.3 People receiving Income Support.
- 2.4 People receiving Council Tax or Housing Benefits.
- 2.5 People in receipt of Working Tax Credit (subject to income).
- 2.6 People receiving support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
 - To obtain a concession rate the user must have either a current valid Leisure Concession card, National Entitlement card with valid entitlements or proof of individual entitlements.

Groups

- 2.7 Community groups constituted to organise programmes that promotes Community Learning and Development. This does not include properties leased to Dundee Leisure.
- 2.8 National voluntary organisations that provide a service to Dundee City Council that are on the DCC approved list.
- 2.9 Organisations that are members of Sport Dundee.
 - Concession rates will be granted for indoor & outdoor sports when over 75% of participant have a Leisure Concession Card or can prove their entitlement.

3.0 COMMERCIAL RATES

3.1 Any individual or company that gains private benefit for themselves or their company, from the let.

4.0 FREE LETS

- 4.1 Free lets can be allowed in exceptional circumstances for a stated period of time at the discretion of the Chief Executive, Director of Education or Director of Leisure and Communities.
- 4.2 Dundee Leisure or their successor will be able to provide free lets in their leased properties at the discretion of their Board.
- 4.3 Any staff member of Dundee City Council can use a City Council facility for free, if it is to undertake part of their work with groups. This includes Out of School Clubs chairs

- or leaders but it does not include properties leased to Dundee Leisure or their successor. The City Council staff member must make the relevant booking.
- 4.4 All Councillor's Surgeries will be provided free of charge in all facilities with any associated costs being absorbed by the relevant departments.
- 4.5.1 All Community Councils and Neighbourhood Representative Structures meetings will be provided free of charge.
