## 1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To authorise the purchase of replacement shredder parts for use in the recycling equipment at Baldovie Waste Processing Plant within Waste Management.

#### 2.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

- 2.1 It is recommended that both of the offers detailed from the specialist suppliers below are accepted.
  - a) Supply & fitment of shredder shafts, cleaning combs & bearings £43,668.63 Blue Machinery (Scotland) Ltd.
  - b) Supply of replacement cutters, spacers, pinions & bull gear £38,652.00

#### 3.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 The total cost of the spare parts and fitting is £82,320.63. Provision for this expenditure has been made in the Waste Management Department's capital budget for 2007/8.

- 6.1 These spare parts forms part of an overhaul of both waste shredding systems at Baldovie. The shredding process allows a substantial amount of commercial and civic amenity waste to be either recycled or rendered as fuel at the DERL Energy from Waste plant.
- 6.2 It is not possible to tender for this equipment since it can only be sourced from the equipment manufacturer. The prices quoted however do include a rebate on the old parts which are to be returned.
