1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To seek approval for the transfer of outdoor adventure activities personnel and activity bases at Ancrum and Grassy Beach Centres from the Leisure & Arts Department to the Neighbourhood Resources & Development Department.

2.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee is asked to approve:

- 2.1 the transfer of outdoor activities instruction and support personnel servicing Ancrum and Grassy Beach Centres from the Leisure & Arts Department to the Neighbourhood Resources & Development Department together with the relevant budget provision as per Appendix 1.
- the renaming of Centres to Ancrum Outdoor Centre and Grassy Beach Outdoor Centre.

3.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 The net costs of operating Outdoor Adventure Activities is £232,555 and is currently included in the Leisure & Arts Department's 2002/2003 revenue budget. This budget will be transferred to the Neighbourhood Resources & Development Department.

The additional cost of the redesignation of the Outdoor Leader to Centre Manager is £3,101 in 2002/2003 and £3,721 in a full financial year and will be met from external finance currently contracted for 3 years to 31 March 2005 from the Better Neighbourhood Services Funding.

6.0 BACKGROUND

6.1 Prior to the 1995 local government reorganisation both Ancrum and Grassy Beach centres were heavily involved in the promotion of outdoor instructor training and the operation of outdoor tuition services associated with the Education/Social Work Departments together with promotion of the Duke of Edinburgh's Award.

This was complemented by provision for public participation in outdoor adventure activities and associated club support.

- 6.2 Since reorganisation the balance of provision has altered due in part to budget constraints and reduced numbers of personnel.
- 6.3 Over the last 2 years several Departments have through external financial support developed initiatives involving outdoor adventure activities as a medium for working with young people displaying challenging behaviour. These initiatives are likely to further develop in the near future and can be better co-ordinated and serviced by improved integration, planning and co-working.
- 6.4 The main provider Departments have discussed these developments and are of a view that the time is opportune to create a more uniform management approach.
- 6.5 The above proposals have the support of the Adventure Activities Licensing Authority who regulate the tuition arrangements for these types of activities.

7.0 CONCLUSION

7.1 The proposals will allow the development of services both to the public and to key Departments working with young people. They will also allow a clear delivery structure for tuition which will aid the Council in the development of external funding applications.

7.2 Both Neighbourhood Resources & Development and Leisure & Arts Departments will continue to work closely to delivery joint programmes of activities especially related to the Camperdown Country Park and the Countryside Ranger Service. It is anticipated that subject to demand a full programme of activities for the public will be maintained.

8.0 CONSULTATION

8.1 The Chief Executive, Directors of Finance, Support Services, Corporate Planning, Education and Social Work together with the trade unions have been consulted and are in agreement with the content of this Report.
