#### RECOMMENDATION

- 1.1 It is recommended that members:

#### 2 RECORDED CRIME

2.1 Dundee LPA evidenced reductions in violent crime when compared to the average of the previous 5 years

A reduction in overall violent crime of 25% (36 fewer victims) A reduction in serious assaults of 20% (11 fewer victims) A reduction in robbery of 45.6% (21 fewer victims) A reduction in common assault of 3.7% (45 fewer victims)

2.2 Reductions were also achieved in

Housebreaking (including attempts) – all property – 35% (149 fewer victims) Shoplifting – 18.5% (171 fewer victims) Vandalism – 29% (375 fewer victims)

# 2.3 Overall, Group 1-4<sup>1</sup> recorded 3867 crimes and evidenced a reduction of 18% compared with the 5 year average (828 fewer crimes).

<sup>1</sup> Groups 1-4 refer to an amalgamation of four crime groups. They are Group 1, consisting of violent crime; Group 2 covering sexual offences; Group 3, the largest, covers a wide range of crimes of dishonesty; and Group 4 includes vandalism, fire-raising, and malicious mischief.)





#### **3 DETECTION RATES**

3.1 Improvements in detection rates, against the 5 year average were evidenced in the following:-

Serious assault 95.5% - 5 year average 75.5% Robbery 80.0% - 5 year average 57.9% Common assault 71.7% - 5 year average 68.1%

3.2 Detection rates for the following were below the 5 year average

Housebreaking (including attempts) 18.1% - 5 year average 29.0% Shoplifting 80.6% - 5 year average 87.5% Vandalism 25.4% - 5 year average 28.3%

#### 4 ROAD SAFETY

4.1 Reductions were recorded in all three measures of road casualties when compared to the five year average:-

People killed/seriously injured 13 - 5 year average 31 People slightly injured 88 - 5 year average 120 Children killed/slightly injured 1 - 5 year average 7

4.2 Significant detections for the following were above the five year average and this is due to emphasis on enforcement to influence driver behaviour to keep people safe and deny criminals the use of the road networks:-

Speeding 843 – 5 year average 289 Seat belt offences 462 – 5 year average 83 Mobile phone offences 386 – 5 year average 85

#### 5 PUBLIC PROTECTION

5.1 181 crimes of indecency were recorded, a 54.7% increase on the 5 year average of 117, with rapes accounting for 20% of the total recorded.

Of the total Group 2 crimes reported between April and September 2013, 20% have a committed date before October 2011 (historical flag). A further 20% have committed dates between April 2012 and March 2013. Recent, well publicised cases involving historic abuse have, perhaps, given victims greater confidence to report matters to the police knowing they will be thoroughly investigated. Some of the crimes were linked and involved the same victims and/or perpetrator. There was also an increase in crimes linked to the use of internet, phones etc.
