### 1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 The purpose of this report is to seek approval of the scheme for school terms and holidays for session 2010-2011.

### 2.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

2.1 It is recommended that the Education Committee notes and approves the scheme (see Appendix) of school terms and holidays for session 2010-2011.

### 3.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

### 4.0 MAIN TEXT

4.1 The start of session 2010-2011 was agreed by Dundee City Council Education Committee on 24 November 2008 (report no. 549-2008 refers).
4.2 The scheme proposes a school session of 195 days for teaching staff and 189 days for pupils. The pupil session is normally of 190 days duration, but Scottish Government has given approval for an additional in-service day to assist the implementation of the Curriculum for Excellence. This additional day will be Tuesday, 17th August 2010, and pupils will consequently return to school after the summer holiday on Wednesday, 18th August.
4.3 It is therefore proposed that in-service days for teaching staff should be held on 16th and 17th August 2010, 11th \& 12th November 2010, 10th February 2011 (see paragraph 4.4 below) and 27th May 2011.
4.4 Traditionally, the February in-service day has been spread across secondary school clusters. The reason for this arrangement was to enable Quality Improvement Officers to deliver in-service courses across the city, but it had the consequence that some dates aligned with the February mid-term holiday while others did not. Following discussions with Head Teachers and teacher trade unions, it was agreed that there was no longer the same need or demand for this arrangement. It is therefore proposed that the February in-service day should be a citywide day, and end-on to the proposed February mid-term holiday (11th and 14th February).
4.5 The proposed autumn fortnight is in accordance with established practice.
4.6 Christmas Day falls on a Saturday. It is therefore proposed that schools will close on Wednesday, 22nd December 2010 and re-open for the spring term on Thursday, 6th January 2011.
4.7 Good Friday is on Friday 22 April and will be a holiday.
4.8 The May Day holiday is on the first Monday in May (2nd) and the Victoria Day holiday is on the last Monday of that month (30th).
4.9 The end of session will be Friday, 1 July 2011.

### 5.0 POLICY IMPLICATIONS

5.1 This report has been screened for any policy implications in respect of sustainability, strategic environmental assessment, anti-poverty, equality impact assessment and risk management.
5.2 There are no major issues.

### 6.0 CONSULTATIONS

6.1 This report has been the subject of consultation with the Chief Executive, Depute Chief Executive (Support Services), Director of Finance, teacher associations, Head Teacher organisations, staff unions, and the Directors of Education in Angus, Fife and Perth \& Kinross Councils.
