#### 1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 This report seeks approval to accept the offer for the refurbishment and provision of offices at the Music Centre.

#### 2.0 **RECOMMENDATION**

- 2.1 It is recommended that the Education Committee:
  - i) notes the content of this report; and
  - ii) approves the offer from Dundee Contract Services for the general refurbishment and provision of offices for Education Department cultural and art staff at the Music Centre.

## 3.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 The cost of this work is £29,574. This expenditure can be met from the Education Capital Budget 2010-11. The revenue implication arising from this expenditure in respect of financing costs is £2,274 per annum.

## 4.0 MAIN TEXT

- 4.1 The Music Centre requires general refurbishment including replacement heaters, floor coverings, the upgrade of existing fire doors and the removal and replacement of old and cracked floor tiles.
- 4.2 Dundee Contract Services have submitted an offer for this work under the Property Maintenance and Small Works Partnership contract.
- 4.3 This proposal will allow the Director of Education to redeploy 5 cultural and art staff presently located at the Educational Development Service within the Rockwell building to the Music Centre as part of the Council's overall ongoing office rationalisation strategy.

## 5.0 POLICY IMPLICATIONS
