 Attached is a summary of the tender returns.
- 6.3 The 3.5 tonne drop-side pick-up is similar to those in existing use and is the most economic tender.
- The compact mechanical road sweeping vehicle recommended for purchase from Applied Sweepers is similar to that in existing use. The successful tender was the most competitive of the minimum specification required.
