External Wall Insulation Programme



External Wall Insulation Programme

What is happening?

Dundee City Council is working with Scottish and Southern Energy (SSE) to carry out a programme of works to fit insulation to blocks in your area. This is known as External Wall Insulation.

Why is Dundee City Council doing this?

The works will make your home more energy efficient by reducing the heat loss through walls and improving the thermal performance and will help to reduce your fuel bills.

The funding for the programme comes from Dundee City Council, the Scottish Government and SSE. This funding allows the work to be offered to owners.

We have already completed several programmes like this in the city, some of which you may have seen in areas such as Woodside (off Graham Street), Clepington Road, Caird Avenue and Arklay Street amongst others.

We have now installed external wall insulation to almost 2,000 homes and residents are already reporting lower heating bills as a direct result of the works.

This is what your block could look like once the new insulation is on.



If I own my home, can I still have the work done?

Yes, you can enjoy the benefits of making your flat easier and cheaper to heat and the works may increase the value of your property. But, in order for you to take up offer, you must sign a consent form.

Tenants do NOT need to consent to the work as Dundee City Council will act on your behalf to agree to the work being done.

How much will this cost?

There is no cost to owners (this includes private Landlords).

The value of all the works carried out to each block is several thousand pounds and is covered by the funding mentioned above. This includes the insulation works, the complete site set up costs, all scaffolding costs, the cost of the renewal of downpipes/ stack pipes, other ancillary works and all professional fees.

Who provides the insulation?

Dundee City Council is currently working with a company called Alsecco*, who are working throughout the UK on a number of similar projects.
