

## COMPETITION RULES

The competition is open to all photographers living within the boundaries of Dundee, and to all members of Dundee Photographic Society.

The entry form must be completed and submitted with each entry.

**Category 1** - monochrome prints

**Category 2** - colour prints

**Category 3** - projected image

**Category 4** - under 18 - Jim Coleman Trophy

A maximum of 6 images, monochrome print, colour print or projected image may be submitted. All prints must be mounted.

Photographs must have been taken within one year of the entry date.

Entries from previous years' competitions are not eligible.

Entry forms for prints and/or digital entries to be handed in with entry fee to External Competitions Secretary at DPS.

The closing date for entries - **Monday 25 January 2016** - is final, and no submissions made after that date will be considered by the judges.

Entry Fee - £6

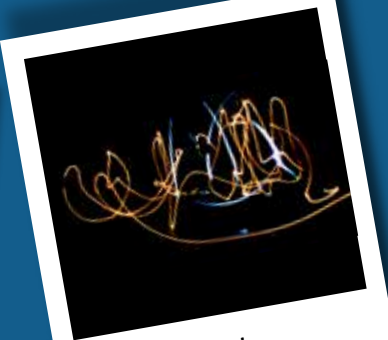
Care will be taken with all entries but neither Dundee City Council nor Dundee Photographic Society can accept responsibility for any loss or damage.

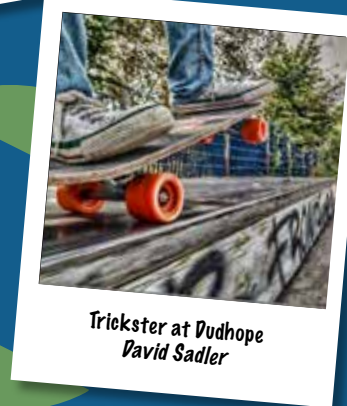

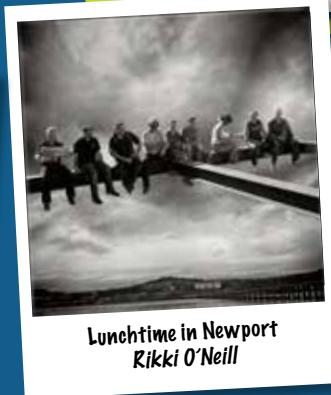

Digital Image File Requirements

- a) Files must be JPEG format, RGB mode.
- b) The maximum dimensions of submitted file must be 1920 pixels horizontal by 1200 pixels vertical (please note, **NOT** 1920 pixels vertical). Entrants are free to make whatever use they choose of the area within these dimensions.
- c) An image will be disqualified if it shows on screen the title or the name, club or author.
- d) Digital projected submissions to be submitted to **external@dps-online.co.uk**
- e) Digital files should be titled as follows:  
*Name\_ (C for Colour) or (M for Mono) or (P for Projected)\_poty\_Title*

Monochrome and Coloured prints

- a) All prints should be mounted suitably on card. The overall size, including mount should be 500mm x 400mm. No other sizes will be accepted.
- b) Print entries must be accompanied by a digital version which should be sent via email, as per the digital file requirements above, to allow the projection of the image to be displayed on the night of the competition.
- c) Please include the title **ONLY** of image on the back of print.

Trophy

Dundee Corporation Trophy

This trophy, together with a miniature and prize voucher, is awarded for the best 3 images in print and/or projected image with the highest total marks in the competition which best portray Dundee.

Robert Saunders Trophy

This trophy was presented by Messrs Robert and Ivan Saunders to commemorate their father who was an early exponent of colour photography. Awarded annually with a miniature for the best projected image taken in any park in Dundee.

Dundee Photographic Society Trophy - Open Competition

The DPS trophy was donated by Dundee Photographic Society in recognition of the photographer who, overall, obtains the highest aggregate points from projected image, monochrome and colour print sections in the open competition. This will automatically include all images submitted for the Dundee Corporation and Robert Saunders Competitions.
