## Dear Sir/Madam

Tenant safety is our first priority and as you know we wrote to you on 16 June 2017 advising you on the measures in place to ensure fire safety in multi storeys and also enclosed a fire safety leaflet from the Scottish Fire and Rescue Service. You can book a free home safety visit by telephoning 0800 0731 999 or text 'FIRE' to 80800.

The insulation and cladding materials used in the refurbishment of our multi storeys meets the highest safety standards. None of our multi storeys in Dundee have the cladding systems or materials used in the Grenfell Tower.

We are now arranging drop in sessions for tenants at each multi storey complex.

Monday, 3 July - Dallfield Tuesday, 4 July - Kirk Street/Adamsons/Elders Courts Wednesday, 5 July - Whorterbank/Ancrum/Burnside Courts Thursday, 6 July - Lansdowne/Pitalpin Courts

The Scottish Fire and Rescue vehicle will be in the car park at your multi storey from 3.00pm to 6.00pm, where you can come along to discuss any concerns with Council and Scottish Fire and Rescue officers.

If you are unable to attend the drop in sessions please speak to your caretaker who will organise a home visit.


