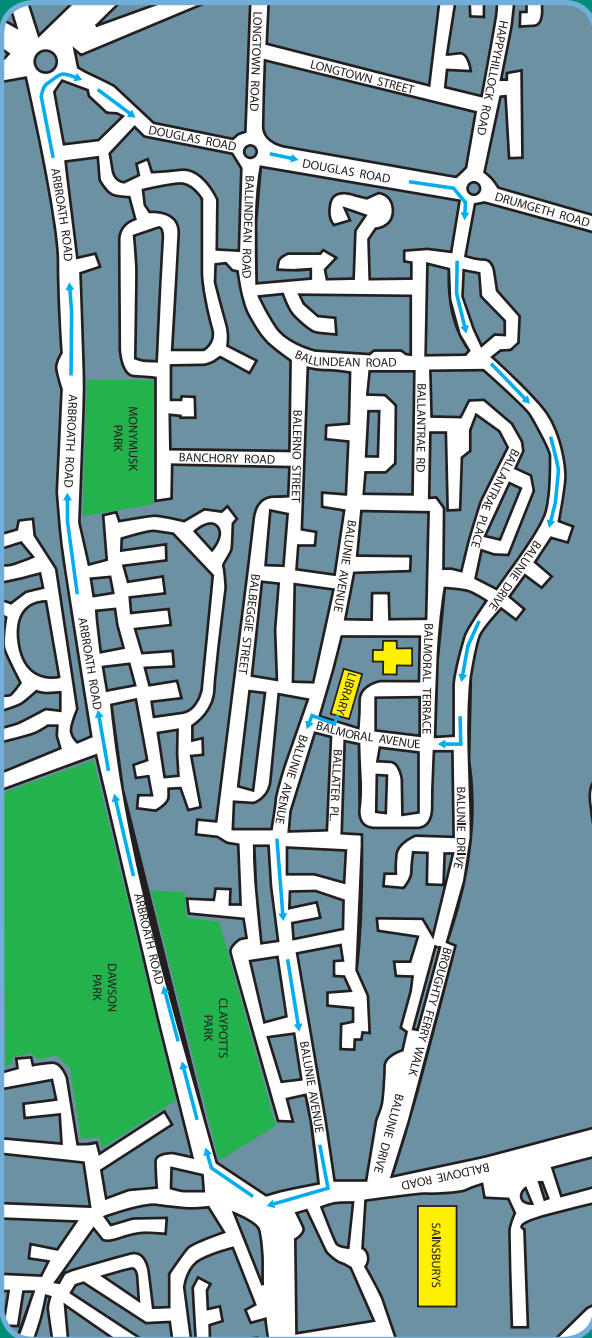

Directions

Start outside the library on Balmoral Avenue. Turn to your right and walk to the top of the road. Cross over Balunie Avenue, turn left and walk along to the end of Balunie Avenue. Turn right onto Baldovie Road and then right again onto Arbroath Road. Walk along the Arbroath Road until you reach the Scott Fyffe Circle. Turn right and walk up towards Asda. Continue down to the end of Douglas Road and turn right onto Balunie Drive. Continue along Balunie Drive and turn right into Balmoral Avenue. Walk back to the library to finish.

Points of interest

- Roundabouts on the Kingsway are known as circles because they were designed by James Thomson, (the Caird Hall Architect) as the first in Scotland in 1918.
- You will pass 3 Parks on the Arbroath Road - Claypotts Park, Dawson Park and Monymusk playing field.
- Look out for Claypotts Castle before Dawson Park.
- Claypotts Castle was built 1569-1588, by John Strachan. It's an excellent example of a Z-plan castle, with towers at diagonally opposite corners: note how the gun-ports cover all the walls.
