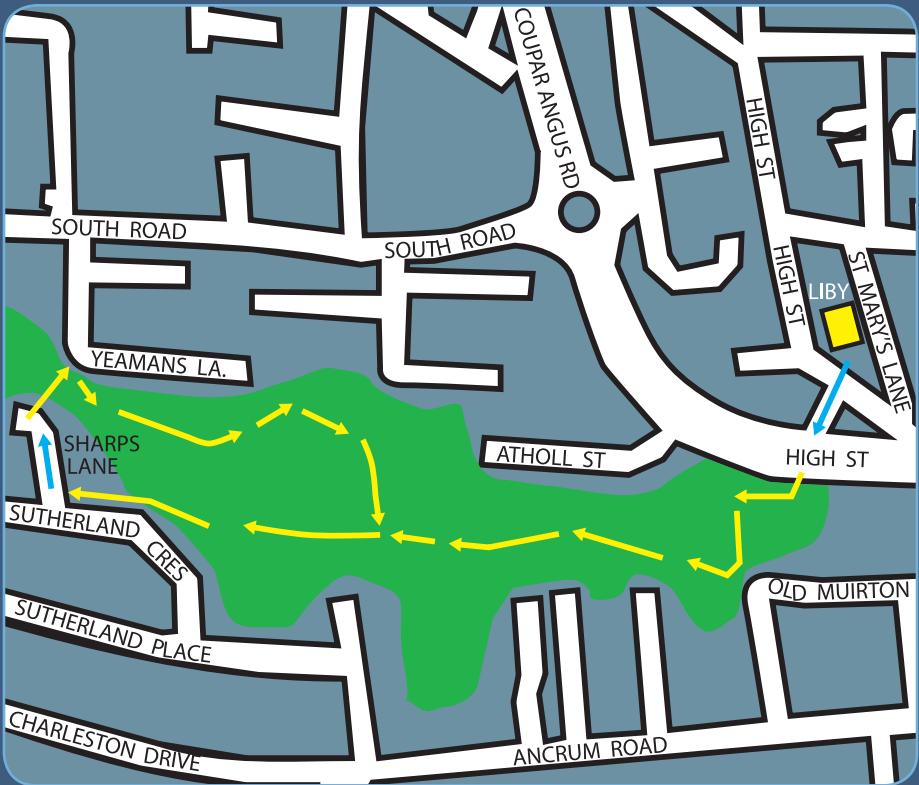




Old Railway Stroll

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Old Railway Stroll



Directions

Start outside Lochee Library. Cross over the High Street and walk towards the Coupar Angus Road. Walk under the Coupar Angus Road using the underpass. Turn to your right and follow the path. Turn right again and follow the path up to the top of the green space. Turn right and walk along the top path. Exit onto Sutherland Crescent, then turn right onto Sharps Lane. At the end of Sharps Lane, cross over the bridge and follow the path down onto the old railway. Turn left and walk along the path, then turn right and follow the steps up to the top path. Retrace your steps back to the library.

Points of interest

- The red stone public baths and library were paid for by the mill-owning Cox Family and was built in 1894-6.
- This path used to form part of the Dundee - Newtyle railway.
- The station in Lochee is now the Lochee Burns Club.
