2 DURA STREET ENVIRONMENTAL IMPROVEMENTS (AN11-2004)

On the instruction of the Director of Planning and Transportation proposals have been prepared for carrying out further environmental improvements to the Dura Street corridor. These are works which are integral to the overall scheme which includes Stobswell and Dens Road junctions, but which were omitted pending funding. As such, these proposals repeat the features and materials at these junctions.

Funding has now been made available by Scottish enterprise Tayside. To ensure that these works are completed within the current financial year an offer has been negotiated with Tayside Contracts, who carried out the original contract as part of the North East/North West Corridor Public Transport Priorities Partnership. The offer reflects rates that have been demonstrated as competitive.

Approval is now sought to accept this offer amounting to \pounds 71,092.62. Allowances of \pounds 8,000 for professional fees and \pounds 507.58 for contingencies give an overall expenditure of \pounds 80,000. The whole cost of this project is to be met from a confirmed SET contribution of \pounds 80,000.
