## 4 A FUEL POVERTY STRATEGY FOR DUNDEE (AN251-2004)

The Housing Committee of 15th March, 2004 (Article V refers) agreed the Fuel Poverty Strategy for Dundee, although some of the statistical information in the strategy was based on figures from the Scottish House Condition Survey 2002 which needed to be revised because of a technical error.

Communities Scotland has now issued revised figures and the Fuel Poverty Strategy has been amended accordingly. The main change for Dundee is that the re-analysis shows that the number of fuel poor households has decreased by 2,000 people or 3% from the original figure.

However, as fuel poverty continues to be an issue for over 9,000 people in Dundee, they key tasks in the Action Plan have not changed in spite of these revised figures.
