## 4 CIVIC GOVERNMENT (SCOTLAND) ACT 1982 - PROPOSED NEW STREET NAMES - NEW ROAD AT CHURCHILL PLACE/EAST LINKS PLACE, BROUGHTY FERRY (AN5-2014)

Consultation on a new street name for a new road being constructed at the above site commenced on 26th November, 2013 and concluded on 16th December, 2013.

The consultation correspondence was put to the Ward Councillors, City Archivist, Agent, Communities Officer and Broughty Ferry Community Council.

Suggestions were requested for the new street name asking for reasons for the choice. The following proposals were received:-

- 1. **Sandy Loan** suggested by members of the community via the Communities Officer. It was also suggested by two Ward Councillors and members of Broughty Ferry Community Council.
- 2. **Agnes Forbes Blackadder** suggested by a member of Broughty Ferry Community Council. Agnes Forbes Blackadder was a native of Broughty Ferry and a distinguished surgeon.
- 3. **Cowans Place/Court** suggested by a Ward Councillor and the City Archivist. David Scott Cowans was a wine and spirit merchant who owned a large portion of the developing Victorian burgh of Broughty Ferry.
- 4. **Adams Terrace** suggested by a Ward Councillor referring to Captain William Adams and his son of the same name who were both Arctic whalers and explorers.
- 5. **Churchill Court** suggested by the agent/developer linking the name to the existing Churchill Place.
- 6. **Churchill Wynd/East Links Wynd** suggested by a Ward Councillor again linking the names to existing names in the area.
- 7. **Salisbury Place/Hartington Place** suggested by the City Archivist to re-instate names used in the area around the time of 1884.

Consideration was given to all the proposed names and it was concluded that **Sandy Loan** should be put forward as the official name for this new street.

Committee is therefore asked to approve the new street name of **Sandy Loan**.
