## 5 TREE PRESERVATION ORDERS (AN7-2013)

## 09/2012 - GEMINI CRESCENT, DUNDEE TECHNOLOGY PARK, DUNDEE

Members are asked to note on 1st November, 2012, the Council made a Tree Preservation Order on the above-mentioned site. This was done to protect the arboreal amenity of the area. The trees currently have no protection because they are not located within a conservation area and the council has received enquiries to remove trees in this area.

No objections have been received.

## 10/2012 - GLENMARKIE TERRACE, DUNDEE

Members are asked to note on 7th November, 2012, the Council made a Tree Preservation Order on the above-mentioned site. This was done to protect the arboreal amenity of the area. Some of the trees are located on Council land. Council trees are not usually protected by a Tree Preservation Order. However, in this case, a number of residents have requested tree removal due to blocking sunlight/daylight and leaf nuisance. However, as this area is not located within a conservation area the trees currently have no protection. These trees were part of the original landscaping for the planning permission when the houses were built. There are a number of mature trees which are worth protecting.

A couple of letters were received from neighbouring properties querying land ownership. However no letters of objections have been received.

Members are asked to authorise the Head of Democratic and Legal Services and the Director of City Development to undertake the necessary procedures and confirm the above Tree Preservation Order.
