### 1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To give further details on the city-wide recycling initiatives planned for the forthcoming months under the National Waste Strategy, and seek Committee approval for these. Reference is made to Article II of this Committee of 21st June 2004.

2.1 It is recommended that the projects detailed within this report be approved.

## 3.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

- 3.1 The projects will be funded in full by the Strategic Waste Fund administered by the Scottish Executive.
- 3.2 The costs for this phase of the expansion of the domestic green waste and domestic paper collection schemes in 2007/2008 are estimated at £336,417.

### 6.0 MAIN TEXT

6.1 The Dundee City Council Implementation Plan provides the fundamental infrastructure to allow the aims and objectives of the Tayside Area Waste Plan to be met locally, in a methodical and planned manner. The plan outlines on a year by year basis the operational projects to be undertaken to this end. For 2007/08, these are:

- 6.2 Expansion of the domestic green waste (brown bin) collection service to include a further 3300 properties. This is a further phase of the expansion approved by Committee on 21st June 2004 (ref. report No. 476-2004), and these additional properties will be included in the domestic green waste collection scheme from May 2007.
- 6.3 The main new areas to be included are detailed in Appendix A, but pockets of properties adjoining existing routes but not currently offered the service will also be incorporated wherever possible. A full list of applicable streets will be provided to the relevant Ward Councillors.
- 6.4 Expansion of the domestic paper (blue bin) collection service city-wide to include an additional 2230 properties. This is a further phase of the expansion approved by Committee on 18 April 2005 (ref. report No. 273-2005), and this expansion is also scheduled for commencement in May 2007. The main new areas to be included are detailed in Appendix A. A full list of applicable streets will be provided to the relevant Ward Councillors.
- Further expansions of both services are to be carried out later in 2007/2008, and will be reported to Committee at an appropriate time.
