1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To gain Committee approval for further environmental improvements as part of the 2016/17 programme.

4. MAIN TEXT

- 4.1 Reference is made to Item (v) of the Policy and resources Committee of the 7 December 2015 Street Cleaning and Open Space Management review where there was agreement to introduce a programme of capital expenditure focused on improvement projects. The proposed projects have been designed to improve and enhance the local environment for residents and members of the public.
- 4.2 These projects have been developed in consultation with Community Officers and local groups. The proposed works will comprise of a number of improvements including:
 - Seabraes Redesign and landscape improvements to south banking, including improvements to soft landscaped areas with new improved planting and introduction to wildflower/naturalised panels. Improvements to existing seating.
 - **Claypotts Park** Part replacement of existing chain link fence to enhance safety of Playpark Boundary. Also, removal of North Chain link fence upgrading with new fence in keeping with Boundary fence.
 - Monymusk Park Upgrading of South Boundary fence keeping in with recently installed fence. Improvement and extension to existing car park to cope with demand and reducing pressure on nearby residents. Enhancement to soft landscaped areas by additional tree planting and installation of benches/ bins.

• Fairmuir Park – Redesign and Landscape improvements by incorporating the old bowling green into the public park with the introduction of a Community Garden area. Existing footpath to be removed and replaced with additional tree planting and wildflower/naturalised areas.
