1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

6.0 BACKGROUND

- At its meeting on 10 February 1997, the Committee approved the criteria and procedures for the Department's grant aid portfolio (Report No 127/1997 refers).
- 6.2 Dundee Rep and The Space have developed proposals for a three-week summer school of dance and theatre which will coincide with the proposed Dundee Summer Festival.
- The first week will offer 175 participants a taster programme for primary and secondary school age pupils.
- The second and third weeks offer 150 places on a two-week intensive programme for young people aged 11-13 and those in the 13-18 age range.
- This is the first of what it is hoped will be a three-year initiative. The Leisure and Communities Department is being asked to pump prime the programme with a grant of £3.350.
- 6.6 The Community Regeneration Fund and other partners will also be asked to assist to ensure that there are no barriers in terms of affordability to young people from Dundee taking part in these initiatives.
