1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 This report details the proposals received for the supply and delivery of ϵ portable screen system for the McManus Galleries and Museum, and requests a decision on acceptance of the same.

4.0 TENDER REPORT

- 4.1 The McManus Redevelopment Display Design includes the purchase of ε portable screen system. This is required to provide additional hanging space and ensure greater flexibility of the gallery spaces, enabling exhibition displays to be shown in a variety of formats.
- 4.2 There are a limited number of suppliers of these systems and two were invited to submit a written quotation, following a practical demonstration of their product. Both returned written quotations and are detailed as follows:

- 4.3 The quotes were evaluated using a pre-determined list of criteria and the recommended system is the only solution which matches all the essential criteria to a satisfactory level.
- 4.4 It is recommended that the quote from PANELOCK SYSTEMS LIMITED is accepted.
