RECOMMENDATION

- 1.1 It is recommended that members:

2 RECORDED CRIME

2.1 Dundee LPA evidenced reductions in violent crime when compared to the average of the previous 5 years

A reduction in overall violent crime of 31.5% (75 fewer victims)

A reduction in serious assaults of 24.7% (23 fewer victims)

A reduction in robbery of 53.2% (41 fewer victims)

A reduction in common assault of 5.0% (98 fewer victims)

2.2 Reductions were also achieved in

Housebreaking (including attempts) – all property – 31.9% (223 fewer victims)

Shoplifting – 24.3% (372 fewer victims)

Vandalism – 25.9% (531 fewer victims)

2.3 Overall, Group 1-4¹ recorded 6041 crimes and evidenced a reduction of 20.5% compared with the 5 year average (1562 fewer crimes).

¹ Groups 1-4 refer to an amalgamation of four crime groups. They are Group 1, consisting of violent crime; Group 2 covering sexual offences; Group 3, the largest, covers a wide range of crimes of dishonesty; and Group 4 includes vandalism, fire-raising, and malicious mischief.)

3 DETECTION RATES

3.1 Improvements in detection rates, against the 5 year average were evidenced in the following:-

Serious assault 95.7% - 5 year average 76.2% Robbery 80.6% - 5 year average 61.7% Common assault 77.9% - 5 year average 67.3%

3.2 Detection rates for the following were below the 5 year average

Housebreaking (including attempts) 18.1% - 5 year average 27.5% Shoplifting 81.0% - 5 year average 86.8% Vandalism 25.4% - 5 year average 28.5%

4 ROAD SAFETY

4.1 Reductions were recorded in all three measures of road casualties when compared to the five year average:-

People killed/seriously injured 37 – 5 year average 48 People slightly injured 144 – 5 year average 201 Children killed/slightly injured 3 – 5 year average 9

4.2 Significant detections for the following were above the five year average and this is due to emphasis on enforcement to influence driver behaviour to keep people safe and deny criminals the use of the road networks:-

Speeding 1226 – 5 year average 496 Seat belt offences 620 – 5 year average 111 Mobile phone offences 590 – 5 year average 126

5 PUBLIC PROTECTION

5.1 251 crimes of indecency (Group 2) were recorded, a 32% increase on the 5 year average of 190, with rapes accounting for 23% of the total recorded.

Of the total Group 2 crimes reported, 59% occurred during the current year. The remainder occurred during previous years but were only recently reported. Recent, well publicised cases involving historic abuse have, perhaps, given victims greater confidence to report matters to the police knowing they will be thoroughly investigated. Some of the crimes were linked and involved the same victims and/or perpetrator. There was also an increase in crimes linked to the use of internet and social media.
