Assessment Criteria:

- The extent to which the aims of the application meet the aims of the scheme.
- The relevance of the application to the delivery of quality Leisure and Communities services in Dundee.
- The expected impact of Council support on the applicant organisation's ability to deliver Leisure and Communities services in Dundee.
- Evidence of sound organisational and financial management.
- Production of a balanced project budget eligible costs up to the sum applied for.

6.2 Purpose of Grant

The grant will enable the Random Theatre to set up a residency in the Caird Hall between March and September 2007 to provide a platform for young people to gain new skills and new confidence by becoming involved in theatre. This will centre around a production written by a local writer entitled "These Are My Mountains".
