1 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 This report considers a request for alterations to waiting restrictions in the Dickson Avenue and Earn Crescent areas of Menzieshill, Dundee to accommodate a new school which is under construction.

2 RECOMMENDATION

2.1 It is recommended that the Committee is asked to approve the preparation of a Traffic Regulation Variation Order to effect the changes to the waiting restrictions in the relevant Traffic Regulation Order for Dundee.

3 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 The costs of preparing the Order will be met by the capital fund for the project.

<u>Dickson Avenue - Lochee Ward</u>

As a result of a new vehicle access to be constructed to access the school, it is necessary to move a section of limited waiting to the west. A section of residents only parking will also be extended.

Earn Crescent - Lochee Ward

To promote road safety and ease anticipated road congestion, it is necessary to remove sections of free available parking and implement two sections with an "at any time" restriction. The offset of this alteration will be accommodated by a temporary car park to be constructed close to the Dickson Avenue/Earn Crescent junction and will also contain a pick up/drop off facility.
