Approval by the Director Neighbourhood Resources and Development, in conjunction with the undernoted, is requested for grant applications from the undernoted so urgent works can be progressed.

Social Inclusion Partnership 1

- Chalmers/Ardler Trust – Elderly Project (CRF50) – to the value of £250. This grant is to meet the cost of a health and fitness pilot project for the elderly group.
- Dundee Rep – Women’s Performing Network Strictly Tea Dance – Remembering the Palais (CRF52)– to the value of £600. This grant is to meet the cost of holding a Tea Dance for SIP 1 residents in the Woodlands Hotel as part of the Women’s Performing Network.
- Hilltown SIP Group – Hilltown Road Safety Campaign (CRF56) – to the value of £1,600. This grant is to meet the cost of publicity, photocopying and distribution of materials for road safety campaign.
- Sanctuary Scotland – Ardler Spring Clean (SU1/6) – to the value of £3,600. This grant is to meet the cost of cleaning 40 closes in low rise blocks.
- Kirkton NDG – Spring Clean (SU1/7) – to the value of £17,715. This grant is to meet the cost of spring cleaning, fencing, ground clearance and planting.
- Planning & Transportation – Lighting Security (SU1/8) – to the value of £2,500. This grant is to meet the cost of purchasing steel bars to secure lighting columns and feeder pillars.
