#### 1.0 PURPOSE

1.1 To authorise the purchase of two replacement domestic refuse collection vehicles (split lifts), one replacement recycling collection vehicle, one replacement commercial refuse collection vehicle (trade lift), three replacement 3.5 tonne team sweeping vehicles one replacement 7.5 tonne suction sweeping vehicle, and one replacement compact suction sweeping vehicle.

### 2.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

- 2.1 It is recommended that the committee accept the offers from the suppliers detailed below (as highlighted in the attached synopsis of tenders), which are the most advantageous to the Council.

3.1 This expenditure of £657,819 can be met from the Waste Management Department's 2005/06 Capital Budget.

# 6.0 MAIN TEXT

- 6.1 The Waste Management Department require to renew a number of vehicles which are beyond economic repair.
- 6.2 Dundee City Council went out to tender in December 2004 to seek the best and most cost effective vehicle replacement types.Attached is a summary of the tender returns.

- 6.3 The domestic refuse collection vehicles recommended for purchase from Dennis Eagle are the only refuse collection vehicles which supply both the body and chassis. All other RCV's are combinations of different chassis and collection bodies. This type of single manufactured vehicle tends to give fewer problems with equipment interfacing and minimises downtime which disrupt collections. Previous experience of the Dennis chassis and body type is very favourable.
- 6.4 The recycling collection vehicle recommended for purchase from JR Weir, Dundee is similar to those in the existing fleet which have given good service.
- 6.5 The commercial refuse collection vehicle recommended for purchase from Dennis Eagle is as per 6.3 above.
- 6.6 The 3.5 tonne team sweeping vehicles recommended for purchase from G Mutch in Perth are compatible to those in existing service and are the most cost effective.
- 6.7 The 7.5 tonne road sweeper recommended for purchase from Applied sweepers in Falkirk is in line with the model purchased in 2004/5 which has proven to provide very good service.
- 6.8 The compact sweeper recommended for purchase from Schmidt UK is compatable with the types currently in service which have provided very good service.
