#### 1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To authorise the purchase of a road-sweeping vehicle which is to be used for street/road cleaning by the Waste Management Department.

#### 2.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

- 2.1 It is recommended that the committee agree to accept the offer from Applied Sweepers Limited, Falkirk for the supply of a Leyland Daf/Merlin road sweeping vehicle amounting to £81,817.
- 2.2 The vehicle is being procured via the Scotland Excel Heavy Vehicle Framework contract.

#### 3.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 The total cost of the vehicle is £81,817. Provision for this expenditure has been made in the Waste Management Department's Capital Budget for 2008/09.

4.1 The vehicle recommended for purchase will replace an existing vehicle which has reached the end of its economic life.
