1 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 This report considers a request for additions to waiting restrictions in Dalcraig Crescent due to inconsiderate parking at a junction during peak school times.

2 **RECOMMENDATION**

2.1 It is recommended that the Committee approve the preparation of a Traffic Regulation Variation Order to affect the changes to the waiting restrictions in the relevant Traffic Regulation Order for Dundee

3 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 It is proposed that the total cost of implementing these proposals estimated at £300 to be met from within the City Development Car Park Trading Account. An additional £100 is required in annual maintenance costs for lining and this will also be met from within the City Development Department's Car Park Trading Account.

Dalcraig Crescent (See Drawing 1) - East End Ward

As a result of inconsiderate parking close to a junction, it is necessary to introduce parking restrictions to prohibit vehicles from parking and causing an obstruction. It will also promote pedestrian safety during peak school hours.
