3.1 The expenditure of £37,311 in the financial year 2002/03 is included within the current approved Financial Plan for the financial year 2002/03. The grants recommended can be met from these sums.

4.1 By introducing a façade scheme to Albert Street and Hilltown the theme of Dundee 21, "Diversity and local distinctiveness are valued and protected" is encouraged.

5 EQUAL OPPORTUNITIES IMPLICATIONS

5.1 Where possible, all door entrances will provide for disabled access.

6 BACKGROUND

- 6.1 Since the scheme was introduced into parts of Albert Street and Hilltown in financial year 2000-2001, four shops have been improved in Albert Street, while ten shops have been improved in Hilltown.
- 6.2 The current applications are in close proximity to previous grant recipients.
- 6.3 120-122 Albert Street currently a grocer's shop, it will be renovated in a traditional form.
- 6.4 128 Albert Street currently trading as a hairdresser is to be renovated in a traditional form.
- 6.5 140 Albert Street currently vacant, the proposal will match those of adjoing shops.

- 6.6 144-146 Albert Street currently a butcher's shop, the proposals for the new shopfront will match those at 148 and 152 Albert Street.
- 6.7 154 Albert Street this too will match the above and will operate as an office.

7 CONSULTATIONS

7.1 The Chief Executive, Director of Finance, Director of Support Services, Director of Corporate Planning and Director of Neighbourhood Resources Department have been consulted and are in agreement with the contents of this report.
