During the last year it has developed successful partnerships with the Outreach Translation Service and Fairplay Training for lone mothers. The SLA continues to work well as the project develops activities in its new premises at Manhattan Works. This coming year is especially significant as it marks the 40th anniversary of DIWC in Dundee.
