

PROJECT INFORMATION	The works comprise the installation of 3nrs. 7Kw Pop-up Electric Vehicle charging points within an existing parking layby directly opposite 571 and 573 South Road as attached at Appendix 2. This site was selected due to the number of tenements in the area and the lack of off-street parking allocated to those properties. The layout of the pavement offers an ideal opportunity to install pop up chargers into a location where there is a lack of charging infrastructure for local residents. This site is being considered for the integration of an electric car club to support local residents without a car.
