1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To gain Committee approval for further environmental improvements as part of the 2017/18 programme.

4. MAIN TEXT

- 4.1 Reference is made to Item (V) of the Policy and Resources Committee of the 7 December 2015 Street Cleaning and Open Space Management review where there was agreement to introduce a programme of capital expenditure focused on improvement projects. The proposed projects have been designed to improve and enhance the local environment for residents and members of the public.
- 4.2 These projects have been developed in consultation with Community Officers and local groups. The proposed works will comprise of a number of improvements including:-
 - Baluniefield Estate Redesign and landscape improvements to enhance this residential area
 with additional tree planting and bulb/naturalised areas. New sustainable planted areas have
 also been designed to improve the amenity value and improve sight lines. Also, the change
 from grass panel to hardstanding will enhance this area and reduce future maintenance costs.
 - Craigie Drive Estate Redesign and landscape improvements to enhance this main route into the city with additional tree planting and new wildflower/naturalised areas. This will improve the amenity value of the site and also help us play our part in promoting biodiversity. Improvement to sight lines and change to planting schemes will also enhance this area.

• Cemetery Improvements Phase 2 – Landscape improvements to enhance our cemeteries with the removal of small grass panels and replacing with decorative stone gravel. This will in turn improve the visual aspect of the cemetery and also improve efficiencies resulting in savings being made. Re-turfing of sunken lairs will also improve the cemetery for users.
