All the applications were assessed by a professional panel comprising representatives from the Performing Rights Society, Scottish Arts Council and the Cultural Enterprise Office.

All the listed applicants were assessed according to the following criteria:

- the quality of the musician's work
- the expected impact of support on the applicant's creative development
- the clarity of purpose behind the submission and reasons given for applying for an award
- the quality of the information/material supplied
- the level of commitment to development of practice.
