## **1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT**

## **6.0 BACKGROUND**

- 6.1 Report 787-2005 approved by the Communities Committee on 8 November 2004 authorised the budget allocation of £40,000 for commissioned grant assistance for programme support for youth activities during the summer of 2005.
- 6.2 The criteria for award was widely distributed to potential provider agencies to enable bids for grant resources in partnership with local communities.
- 6.3 These bids were submitted to the Dundee Community Safety Partnership Executive on 20 May 2005 and approved subject to the providing organisations providing income and expenditure data, evaluation and monitoring and final programme reports by 1 September 2005.
- 6.4 The successful provider organisations will be briefed on the evaluation and monitoring data requirements for the above.

**7.0 CONSULTATION**

- 7.1 Consultation has taken place with the Chief Executive, Depute Chief Executives (Finance) and (Support Services), Assistant Chief Executive (Community Planning) and the Dundee Community Safety Partnership.
