## 1 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 This report considers the necessity to stop-up the entire length of the Angus Street - Liff Road footpath utilising the powers of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997.

#### 2 RECOMMENDATION

2.1 It is recommended that the Committee approve the preparation of a Stopping-Up Order to stop-up the entire length of the Angus Street - Liff Road footpath to accommodate a new development following planning consent.

## 3 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 The costs of preparing the Order will be met by the developer.

#### 4 BACKGROUND

- 4.1 Following planning approval to construct housing on the vacant site at the corner of Angus Street and Liff Road junction it will be necessary to stop-up the footpath which cuts the corner over the site.
- 4.2 This footpath, which is depicted on the attached plan, will require to be stopped-up.
- 4.3 An alternative route is available via the existing north footway of Liff Road and a footway which will be constructed adjacent to the west side of Angus Street.

#### 5 POLICY IMPLICATIONS

5.1 This Report has been screened for any policy implications in respect of Sustainability, Strategic Environmental Assessment, Anti-Poverty, Equality Impact Assessment and Risk Management. There are no major issues.
