1 PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 This report considers a request for additions to waiting restrictions for Perth Road adjacent to Harris Academy.

2 RECOMMENDATION

- 2.1 It is recommended that the Committee approve the preparation of a Traffic Regulation Variation Order to affect the changes to the waiting restrictions in the relevant Traffic Regulation Order for Dundee.

3 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

- 3.1 The costs of preparing the Order will be met by the developer.

4 BACKGROUND

- 4.1 Following the opening of the new Harris Academy building, it will be necessary to alter waiting restrictions to allow vehicular turnover while also keeping sections of the carriageway free from obstruction.
