#### 1 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To seek Committee approval for the implementation of a Traffic Regulation Order to introduce a one-way traffic restriction in St Columba Gardens.

#### 2 **RECOMMENDATION**

2.1 It is recommended that Committee approve the preparation of the necessary Traffic Regulation Order to introduce a one-way traffic restriction in St Columba Gardens by varying the Tayside Region (Dundee) (One-Way Traffic) (Consolidation) Order 1987.

## 3 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 The costs of preparing the Order will be met by the Traffic Revenue Minor Works budget.

#### 4 BACKGROUND

- 4.1 Due to the increase in traffic flow around Craigowl Primary School since its opening, there has been increased pressure and congestion on the surrounding roads. The increased traffic flow is also causing safety concerns for pedestrians, vehicles and school pupils in the area.
- 4.2 To relieve this pressure, it is proposed to introduce a one-way traffic restriction on St Columba Gardens between its junction with St Clement Place and its junction with the cul-de-sacs at 6-18 (evens) St Columba Gardens and 5-21 (odds) St Columba Gardens in an easterly and then southerly direction.
- 4.3 Alternative routes are available in close proximity which will minimalise disruption for road users and residents.
