## 4 LOCAL AGENDA 21 IMPLICATIONS

4.1 The aims of Local Agenda 21 will be taken into consideration throughout the 'Bringing Confidence into Public Transport' project. The components of the PTIS are aimed at informing the public of their transport choices and encouraging modes of transport other than the car and as such, will contribute to the protection of Dundee's environment.

## 5 EQUAL OPPORTUNITIES IMPLICATIONS

5.1 The City Council acknowledges the dominance of the private car within its transport network. The promotion of public transport by measures included within this report aims to move towards redressing the balance of large numbers of the city's population who do not have access to the private car or who choose to undertake travel by other means.

## 6 BACKGROUND

6.1 Committee Report No 384-2001 approved at Planning and Transportation Committee on 25 June 2001 detailed a bid for funding to the Scottish Executive from their Public Transport Fund for improvements to public transport passenger waiting facilities in the City Centre and at Ninewells Hospital and for a 'step change' in information provision. The project is titled 'Bringing Confidence into Public Transport' and was successful in gaining £2.31 million from the PTF.

- 6.2 A key element of the project is a 'step change' in information provision utilising a Public Transport Information System and this report details tenders received for this element of the project.
- 6.3 The Public Transport Information System will be centred around the development of a bespoke map based interactive journey planning facility for Dundee utilising internet technology.
- 6.4 The journey planner will be made available to the public through a number of sources including interactive information terminals sited at various locations within the city centre and at strategic venues throughout the city, as well as being available through the Council's website.
- 6.5 The interactive terminals will provide a number of ways of selecting journey origins and destinations, including map displays, postcode entry, selecting major geographical destinations and special locations such as sporting and leisure venues and combinations of each.
- 6.6 In addition to providing public transport journey planning, bus routing and timetable information, the map based system will contain a facility to display other information under such headings as tourism, hotel/restaurant details, ward maps of Ninewells Hospital, public buildings (opening times) and general traffic information.
- 6.7 In addition to the journey planning facility, timetable information for individual bus stops will be accessed through SMS text messages on mobile phones. Electronic information display signs located at appropriate locations in the city centre and Ninewells Hospital will also display timetable information for bus services to the public.
