### 1 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 This report considers the necessity to stop-up a length of footpath between Dunholm Road and South Road utilising the powers of the Town & Country (Scotland) Act 1997.

### 2 **RECOMMENDATION**

2.1 It is recommended that the Committee approve the preparation of a Stopping-Up Order to stop-up a length of footpath between Dunholm Road and South Road to accommodate a new development following planning consent.

4.1 As part of the development of new housing the footpath layout will be altered. This will necessitate the stopping-up of a length of the footpath as depicted on the attached plan. As part of the development the footpath will be realigned and the superseded section stopped-up.
