1. Purpose of Report

To obtain approval for the offer to supply hot/cold drinks vending machines from a specialist supplier to the Douglas and Lynch Sports Centres.

2.1 It is recommended that due to the specialist nature of the equipment that in terms of the regulation governing tender procedures of the Council, the offer of £8,488 which includes five year maintenance programme from 'Four Square'', Basingstoke is accepted.

6. Background

6.1 The works comprise the supply and installation of hot/cold drinks vending machines at the Douglas Centre and Lynch Centre.

The machines will replace the existing machines which are becoming difficult to maintain due to their age and the fact that the original supplier who also maintains the machines is no longer in business.

The proposed machines are easier to service and manage due to the dry element of the drinks content being contained within the cup and therefore alleviating problems relating to filling machines with bulk ingredients and effectively being hygienically sound. The system therefore being more failsafe will lead to greater customer satisfaction.

The offer received from 'Four Square' Basingstoke is £8,488. The offer comes with a five year maintenance agreement.

It is recommended that the Committee accepts the offer.
