1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 This report seeks approval for the City Architectural Services Officer to obtain offers, tenders, or negotiate partnerships and for the Director of Support Services in conjunction with the Director of Neighbourhood Resources & Development to accept these offers/tenders/partnership agreements, for Planned Maintenance Works up to a total cost of £125,341 as detailed in Appendix 1

A substantial amount of miscellaneous fabric repairs are required to the Department's buildings. The work is essential to safeguard structures, comply with legislation and ensure the safety of occupants. Phase 1 of these works is to be undertaken at a total cost not exceeding £125,341. It is envisaged that Dundee Contract Services will carry out the majority of these works. To ensure that the repairs are carried out timeously, it is considered beneficial that the Director of Support Services be empowered to accept the most favourable offers and tenders for these works to be undertaken by Dundee Contract Services and other contractors.
