1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To seek approval for Dundee Contract Services to undertake Phase 5 - Arboricultural Works in Baxter Park as part of the park's Restoration Plan.

2.0 RECOMMENDATION

The committee is recommended to:

- 2.1 accept the offer of £6,695 from Dundee Contract Services for Phase 5 Arboricultural Works.
- approve a 5% contingency sum of £335 to be added to the project sum giving a total cost of £7,030.

3.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 The landscape refurbishment works is part of Baxter Park Restoration Plan which is funded by the Heritage Lottery Fund, Historic Scotland and the Leisure and Communities Department.

The total cost of the Baxter Park Restoration project is £3,558,000 and will be funded as follows:

6.0 MAIN TEXT

- 6.1 The tender is for arboricultural works as part of Phase 5 of the Arboricultural Works in the Baxter Park Restoration Plan. The work includes general tree crowning, thinning and pruning throughout the park and removal of diseased or dying trees.
- 6.2 The four companies who were asked to submit a tender for the work were as follows:

ContractorChecked Tender PriceDundee Contract Services£6,695Specialist Tree Services£6,978Arboretum International Ltd£9,102Garden of Eden Tree Care LtdNo quote received

After checking, Dundee Contract Services were found to have a mathematical inaccuracy in their tender. They were informed of this and they revised their tender accordingly. All other tenders were accurate after checking.

- A 5% contingency sum of £335 is recommended due to the nature of the work and the possibility that the requirements for additional tree work may arise.
- 6.4 It is recommended that the Committee approve the appointment of Dundee Contract Services as they have provided the lowest tender and it is a fair and reasonable offer.
