## 1 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 This report considers the necessity to stop-up various lengths of footpaths and roads within Mill o' Mains utilising the powers of the Town & Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997.

#### 2 **RECOMMENDATION**

2.1 It is recommended that the Committee approve the preparation of a Stopping-Up Order to stop-up the various lengths of footpaths and roads in the Barra Terrace, Gruinard Terrace/Mull Terrace and Uist Terrace areas of Mill o' Mains to accommodate a new development following planning consent.

# 4 BACKGROUND

- 4.1 Following planning approval to construct housing on the aforementioned areas it will be necessary to stop-up the lengths of footpaths and roads which will be constructed over as part of the new development.
- 4.2 The lengths of footpaths and roads which are depicted on the attached plans will require to be stopped-up.
- 4.3 Carriageways and footpaths will be realigned or replaced as part of the development.
